





Ali Ibn Rabban al Tabari (838-870 AD)





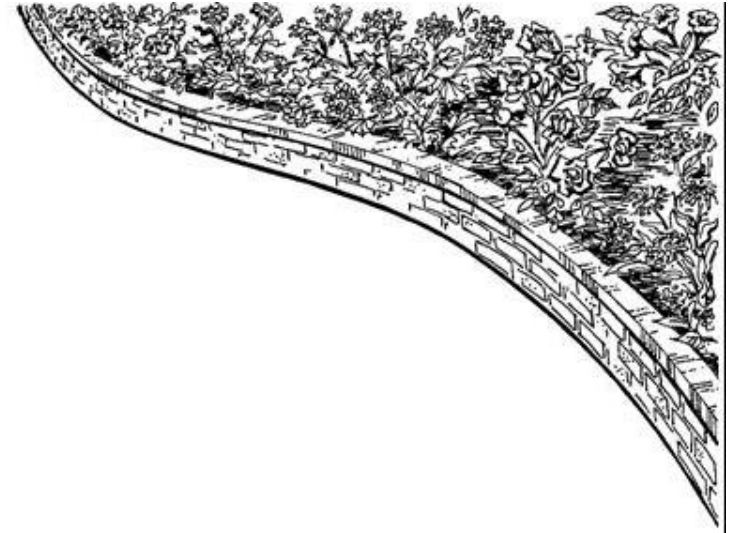
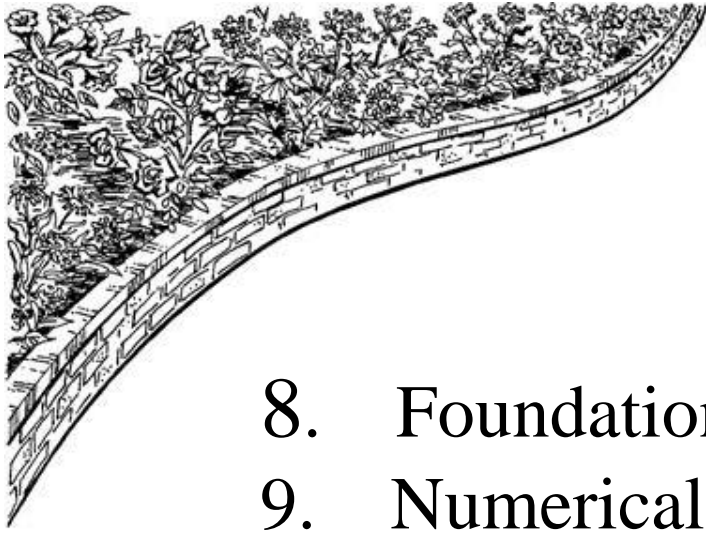
Naseer al Din al Tusi (1201-1274 AD)
